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The Bayfield County 4-H Achievement and Records Committee has established the following purposes for 4-H record books:

- <u>**Record-Keeping Skills**</u>: Youth learn the importance of keeping records.
- <u>Documentation</u>: Record books are a source of documentation for future reference.
- <u>Growth</u>: Record book forms allow youth to demonstrate how they have grown throughout the year.
- <u>Organization</u>: Record books allow youth to develop good organizational methods.
- <u>Financial Records</u>: Youth keep financial records of their project which can be a valuable asset in the future.
- <u>Goals</u>: Record book forms encourage youth to establish their goals for the 4-H year.
- <u>Memories</u>: Record books are a wonderful source of 4-H memorabilia.
- <u>**Responsibility:**</u> Youth practice responsible behavior by completing record books.
