


Winter Camp

CAMP DETAILS/WHAT TO BRING

LODGING

Cabin units are carpeted and heated. Sizes of cabins vary from 8-18 beds per unit. The camp utilizes a common shower area during the winter months. Bedding and towels are NOT provided in cabin units.

MEALS

Three well-balanced meals will be served in the Crosswoods dining area for our group. Breakfast will be served on Sunday. No dinner will be served on Friday night, please plan to eat before you arrive. If you have a long drive home on Sunday plan to stop for food or pack snacks. An evening snack will be served around 10pm.

ACTIVITIES

Broomball, time to explore the beautiful camp surroundings will compliment a rotation of educational rotations. The camp has a limited number of snow shoes available. If you wish to ski and have access to equipment, feel free to bring them.

- ✓ Desire to have fun, learn, and expand your leadership skills




DIRECTIONS TO CAMP CROSSWOODS

To the CrossWoods Center:

From the West: Take Highway 2 east to Iron River, take a right on County H. Proceed for about 14 miles until you see a Delta sign on the right. Take the next road to your right (Delta-Drummond Road/FH 35) for about 4 miles. Look for the CrossWoods Center sign on the left. Take left onto gravel driveway and follow signs to Camp Center.

From the South: Take Highway 63 north until you get to Drummond. After passing the Chequamegon Saloon on the left, take the next left on the Delta-Drummond Road (also called FH35). Go about 7 miles and look for black mailbox and CrossWoods Center sign on the right. Take right onto gravel driveway and follow signs to Camp Center.

From the East: Take Highway 2 west until it intersects with Highway 63 South. Take Highway 63 south through Grand View to Drummond. Just after crossing Flowage Bridge, take next right onto the Delta-Drummond Road (also called FH35). Go about 7 miles and look for black mailbox and CrossWoods Center sign on the right. Take right onto gravel driveway and follow signs to Camp Center.
