





PROPER DISPOSAL OF MERCURY WASTE & LEAD

Simple household items can contain heavy metals and mercury that can contaminate rivers, lakes and fish if not properly disposed. Bring the following items from your home to one of our household hazardous waste collections so they can be recycled or managed properly:

- Lead Tackle
- Split Shot/Weights
- Thermostats and switches
- Fluorescent and HID lamps
- Some types of old paint
- Liquid mercury
- Thermometers

Household hazardous waste will be accepted at the above locations & only at designated times.

Items including: oil-based paints, solvents, pesticides, hazardous cleaners, corrosives, flammables, mercury, lead tackle and shot, old gas, antifreeze, and other chemicals you wouldn't consider dumping.

2020 events will again include medications collections (Excluding Price & Taylor Counties).

-No Sharps Accepted-

Residents are welcome to utilize ANY of the above collections not just the one offered in your particular county.

As long as you are a property owner in one of the 9-counties in the NWRPC service region above you are eligible to use any of the collection events.
