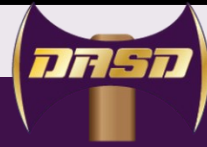

GEORGE TUTTLE



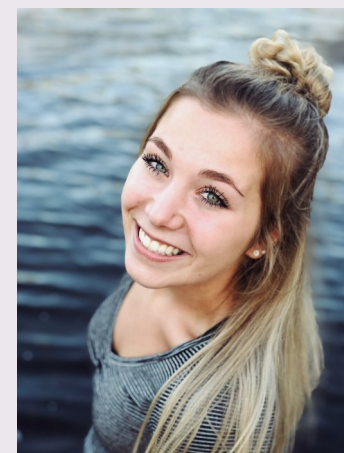
- Drummond High School
