When you arrive at the school you will bring all of your entries to the tables in the commons area outside of the cafeteria. There will be tables set out for the different categories, and you will set up your entries on the correct tables along with your entry information cards. 4-H Ambassadors and staff will be available to assist you and answer any questions you may have.

After you have set up your entries, please get in line to talk to the judges for the categories that you are entering. Please plan to speak with the judge for about 5 minutes. You will have the chance to show the judge your entries and tell them about your work. Be prepared to answer questions that the judges have about your entries like where and when you made them, how long they took you to make, materials and equipment used, planning and vison for the works, struggles you faced, etc.

Please plan to stay for the performances and lunch. Awards will be announced and ribbons will be handed out on-stage after lunch. Things should be wrapped up by about 1:30pm.
