



#### Start a 4-H Record Book!

Interested in starting a record book this year? A 4-H Record Book is a great way to keep track of what you do in 4-H through the years and can serve as an excellent resource in your future. Record books help to teach youth organizational and record keeping skills, and also help youth to set goals and track progress on those goals. All of the information you need to create a 4-H Record Book along with <u>printable forms</u> are located on our <u>website</u>. Many clubs provide the needed papers each year, and you can always contact our office and have us print forms and mail them to you.

#### Permanent record turn-in

Did you know that all 4-H members are encouraged fill out a <u>permanent record</u> each year? Even if you didn't complete a full record book, you can still turn in a <u>permanent record</u> to your club organizational leader to keep track of all that you've done in 4-H. When you fill this out and turn this into your club organizational leader you accrue points and can receive different achievement awards through the Bayfield County 4-H program. These awards are handed out at our fall 4-H Awards & Recognition Dinner each year.
